



How has your relationship with Jesus Christ shaped your career and influenced your decision to apply for this position? Please include an articulation of your alignment with the Reformed tradition (Christian Reformed Church, Reformed Church of America, etc.).
 - » Describe your experience with Christian education, both personally and professionally. How would you define the marks of educational excellence in a Christian school?
 - » Describe your leadership style. If you have taken any leadership inventories (Gallup Strengths, SDI, VIA 24, etc.), feel free to share those results.
- Provide the names and contact information (telephone numbers and email addresses) for four
 references who know you and your career well enough to comment on your suitability for the Head of
