Facility

RVCS was founded in 1911 and opened its doors to students in the fall of 1912. The original building was used until 1919, when students moved to the current location. Since then, the community has continually supported the school in campaigns for upgrades, expansions, and improvements. Most recently, major contributions from the community helped repair the current building after extreme floods this past summer.

Administrator Key Tasks

Administrative Leadership

- Serve as the chief executive officer of the school, reporting directly to the school board and work closely with board president.
- Serve as an advisor to the school board on vision and policy issues and implement duties as assigned by the board.
- Attend all board meetings and attend standing committee meetings as needed.
- Establish annual goals with input from the Executive Committee.
- Build a vibrant, trusting, and healthy organizational culture. Help make RVCS an even better place to work by supporting, developing, retaining, and recruiting exceptional teachers aligned with the Reformed worldview.

Instructional Leadership

- Encourage and plan for the professional growth of faculty and staff members, for the distinctiveness of the Christian school, improved instruction, student needs, collegial efforts, and community relationships.
- With the faculty, develop and implement the stated curriculum for all grades, maintaining an updated curriculum guide.
- Appraise and evaluate employees' work, keeping accurate records of this process.
- Oversee school student issues of academic, social, spiritual, and disciplinary natures.
- Determine the personnel needs of the school, make recommendations to the proper committees, recruit outstanding candidates, and recommend the employment of these candidates to the board.

Operational Leadership

- Operate the school within the adopted operating budget and plan with the board for the future budgetary needs of RVCS. Collaborate with business manager and board treasurer to address any financial problems or concerns.
- Working with the administrative assistant, oversee the preparation and process of documents for application, enrollment, and financial aid.
- Lead development and sustainability of strategic enrollment, marketing, advancement, and other key aspects of school governance and operations.
- Seek to expand and innovate, exhibiting the characteristics of a growth-oriented leader focused on growing enrollment while keeping RVCS accessible to families throughout the local communities.
- Serve as the face of RVCS to the broader community. Actively participate in community events to increase visibility and credibility of the school.

 - » Describe your spiritual journey of faith in Jesus Christ. Indicate how God is using you in your work, in your church, and in your community. How has your relationship with Jesus Christ shaped your career and influenced your decision to apply for this position?
 - » Describe your experience with Christian education, both personally and professionally. How would you define the marks of educational excellence in a Christian school?
 - » Describe your leadership style. If you have taken any leadership inventories (Gallup Strengths, SDI, VIA 24, etc.), feel free to share those results.
- Provide the names, telephone numbers, and email addresses of four references who know you and your career well enough to comment on your suitability for the Administrator role at Rock Valley Christian School.
