TfT Around The Globe: Kpogede Community School







Teaching for Transformation has taken root in four of our international partner contexts (Ghana, Zambia, Dominican Republic, and Belize). For example, students at **Kpogede**Community School in Ghana recently solved an environmental problem at their school in a practical and beautiful way via a FLEx project. When students noticed that plastic sachet water bags were being discarded by either throwing them on the ground or burning them, they recognized an environmental

challenge and an opportunity to be Earth Keepers and Beauty Creators.

Students and staff first sorted plastics from other waste materials and then repurposed the bags by weaving them into a sturdy and colorful fence for their school garden. This initiative has had a transformative impact on the school environment. The once litter-strewn compound is now noticeably cleaner, and the school garden is protected. Even more importantly, the practices of waste management have instilled a sense of responsibility and environmental stewardship



in students and staff alike. They are now actively involved in managing their waste by keeping it off the ground and putting it to constructive use while beautifying their school grounds.



With guidance from teachers who have been trained in TfT through EduDeo's Walking Together program, students like those at Kpogede are being invited to play their role in God's story by identifying opportunities to join in Christ redemptive work. The Walking Together program brings teachers and leaders from all over the world to support, mentor, and guide their peers in training.

Workshop topics include Teaching for Transformation and many others within the areas of classroom learning, leadership development, or organizational investment.

Topics are chosen by EduDeo's local partners to best suit their needs and workshops are facilitated by local and international volunteers called Learning Leaders. Teachers are at the heart of education – that's why all our partnerships start with Walking Together.
